

Study Abroad Program Clearance Instructions

1. CMU Health offers two travel clearance visit types:

- A routine Study Abroad Clearance visit to the Clinic will cover travel to many countries. Please print and complete the document named *Health Forms* and present them the day of your visit.
- A Travel Health Consultation includes an immunization review by clinical staff...
a Travel Health Consultation is necessary for travel to the following countries:

Belize	Brazil	Chile	Costa Rica
China	Dom. Republic	Ecuador	Guatemala
Haiti	Honduras	Hong Kong	India
Korea	Mexico	Panama	Peru
Philippines	Thailand	Vietnam	

Travel to any of the destinations listed above requires a Travel Health Consultation. Two sets of forms are necessary to complete the Travel Health Consultation process.

1. Print and complete the document named *Travel Health Clinic forms* and submit them to Foust Hall Clinic as soon as possible. A Nurse will review your immunization and health records, and then contact you to arrange your Travel Consultation.
2. Print and complete the document named *Health Forms* and bring them with you on the day of your Consultation.

A Typhoid immunization is recommended when traveling to any of the destinations listed above. Be sure to check with your insurance company regarding coverage for this and other vaccines. In addition, if you are traveling in rural areas outside of tourist areas, please check this website to see if Yellow Fever is required: <https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/destinations/list>

NOTE: Travelers to Ghana and Ecuador: Yellow Fever vaccine may be required. Travelers needing Yellow Fever vaccine must visit the Midland Health Department.

2. We can bill your Insurance for your travel visit. **It is important for you to know if this visit is a covered benefit under your Policy.** Please contact your Insurance Company and ask them if visit code **99401** is a payable benefit under your policy. If it is not **or** if you do not have Insurance, you will qualify for a Self-Pay Discount. Self-Pay fee for the visit is \$40 and payment is expected the day of your appointment.

Note: Michigan Medicaid plans do not cover this service. Please be prepared to pay for this service the day of your visit.

3. All Travelers: don't forget, please bring your COMPLETED *Health Forms* with you to the Clinic.
4. Please bring your INSURANCE CARD to your appointment.
5. Immunizations (if needed) are not included in the visit fee. Immunizations are billed separately.
6. Call today, don't wait! And AVOID being a NO SHOW. If you cannot keep your appointment for any reason, please be polite and call the Clinic to cancel and reschedule. We want to accommodate everyone.
